More over, his results from bacterial cultures were SO variable that I cannot acknowledge the conclusions drawn by the author. Work ing in my laboratory, at my instigation, R. Salus has shown that Deutschmann s a priori improbable belief that the infective agent of sympathetic ophthalmia is a sarcine, which within the eve is transformed into a staphylococcus, rests on an illusion. If pure sarcine is injected into an eye, while they produce an in?ammation, they die in a short time. If, however, they are mixed with staph ylococci, while the sarcine dies, the staphylococci remain and may be demonstrated in cultures. Therefore, I do not believe that anyone can accept the conclusions of F. Deutschmann and, in spite of these newest researces, we may leave the migration theory as an entirely unsatisfactory explanation of the origin of sympathetic ophthalmia.
